Wednesday 3rd October 2018 from 8.45am until 1.10pm.

At this event we invite many of the colleges to which your child might consider making an application for September 2019. Also in attendance will be representatives from Training and Apprenticeship Providers involved in placing students with companies offering apprenticeships, Positive Steps Career Service, the Armed Forces and others to be confirmed at time of writing.

- Students will have the opportunity to visit the college stands and discuss with their staff
 important issues such as the success of the college, the subjects it offers? The qualifications
 required for various courses offered? Where the college is? How easy is it to get to? What is
 the social life of the college like? When is the Open Evening? Do they have 'Taster Days'? and
 so on.
- This approach can be used to find information on a range of Apprenticeship places or professional training in The Army, Royal Navy or Royal Air Force.
- Then, they can check out Positive Steps, whose staff will assist them, through this period, in making informed decisions about their career development.
- Students must obtain as much information as they can on a range of colleges and particularly read the prospectuses offered. Students will be briefed on the types of questions they might ask.

Of course we consider the role of the parent as essential in this process. To this end we would encourage you as parents to join the session your child is involved in and assist in making these decisions.
