Please find below information regarding the collection and publication of our students' results.

GCSE RESULTS DAY - Leaver 2018

GCSE results for Year 11 students will be available for collection on THURSDAY 23rd AUGUST 2018 between 10:00am and 1:00pm.

If a student wishes any other person (friend/family member) to collect his/her results on their behalf, **the student** must give his/her written authorisation to school **before Thursday 12th July 2018** to ensure that we are able to meet all requests. Please ensure that your request is marked clearly for the attention of Mrs. Hodgkinson - Exams Office.

Alternatively, if a student wishes his/her exam results to be posted home then please supply the Exams Office before **Thursday 12th July 2018** with a stamped addressed envelope.

No results will be given out by telephone under any circumstances. Any email requests and uncollected results will be dealt with when school re-opens on Tuesday 4th September 2018.

PUBLICATION OF RESULTS - Leavers 2018

The Manchester Evening News Media Newspapers have historically featured GCSE and A-level results for local schools and colleges and in previous years have invited us, along with other local schools, to submit our student's GCSE results for publication in the Manchester Evening News and also on their website and relevant weekly titles.

We intend to submit our results to the Manchester Evening News Media Newspapers on Thursday 23rd August. As in previous years we would expect the format to be similar to the following: -

In alphabetical order by surname followed by first initial, number of 9-1 grades directly followed by the number of 9-4 grades in brackets, and A*-G grades directly followed by the number of A*-C grades in brackets.

For Example:

M Collier 10(9), 3(2); S French 8(5), 3(2); A Hodgkinson 5,2.

So in this instance M Collier received ten 9-1 grades, nine of which were 9-4 grades, and three A*-G grades, two of which were A*-C grades. S French received eight 9-1 grades, five of which were 9-4 grades, and three A*-G grades, two of which were A*-C

grades. A Hodgkinson received five 9-1 grades with no 9-1 passes and two A*-G grades with no A*-C passes.

In the event that the student does not wish to be included in the publication of results in the Manchester Evening News Media Newspapers we will require the written notification **signed by the student and countersigned by a parent/carer** that neither of you wish the results to be published. Please ensure that notification is addressed to Mrs A Hodgkinson - Exams Office and provided to school before Thursday 12th July 2018.
